

# **BOIL ORDER TO USERS OF MUNICIPAL WATER SERVICES**

On Monday, April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2026 the Dept. of Health has enacted a **BOIL WATER ORDER** for users of the Fredericton Junction municipal water system from due to a water break. You are advised to procure water from an alternate safe source or to boil the water for one (1) minute. The “boil water” order shall remain in effect until the results of the required water tests have returned acceptable. There must be two (2) consecutive water samples approved by the Department of Health before the boil water order can be lifted.

Council will continue to remain proactive to ensure a safe municipal water supply for the citizens of the Village.

- Meanwhile, **PLEASE BOIL WATER FOR ONE (1) MINUTE** prior to consumption.
- All water destined for drinking, preparing infant formulas and juices, washing fruits and vegetables, cooking or dental hygiene be held at a rolling boil for 1 minute, or an alternate safe source of water should be used. Toddlers and infants should be sponged bathed and caregivers need to ensure no water is swallowed.
- Tap water may be used for other household purposed, including dish washing.

Your cooperation and patience with the water quality problem we are currently experiencing is appreciated.
