Household Hazardous Waste

You know it's in your basement. Your garage, your shed. It's household hazardous waste and that ranges from paints, to swimming pool chemicals to gasoline, oil and more. There are plenty of ways to properly dispose of your residential hazardous waste including visiting Fredericton Region Solid Waste each Wednesday (7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.) and Saturday (7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.) for free drop-off service.
